the forties hero and fifties heroes all about? If you say that the hero in the fifties that the

different kind of hero. Still, stardom mattered a lot is still, stars for under contract with

And who were these heroes now? So, if you want to think about heroes of the fifties,

then we have to look at the heroes of the forties and fifties also in an even before. So,

there was the huge boxed box office star during the silent period called Rudolf

Velentino. Are you aware of Rudolf Velentino? Are you? No. Take down the name. See,

are doing the course like this, you ought to know Hollywood history, motion pictures

history and only then you can understand any other cinema. Sandeep, who was Rudolf Velentino? Super star of the silent period, can you recall any movie?

So, the sheik was a major major black buster of Rudolf Velentino; and he was the for mixed race extremly handsome, but however the factor miss that he was the first male super star. And basically, he was known for his looks rather than his history on its. So, those classic regard looks and silent stars. So, naturally did not have to speak any lines. He had a strong ascent. He was his dialogue delivery was not very good and there was nothing, except he you know his classic good looks, there was nothing much to recommend him, but still one of the earlier great stars of the period of holly of Hollywood.

And therefore, his name figures, in the greatest stars, are of greatest you know in pantheon in Hollywood start here. With there was like mass hysteria when Rudolf Velentino prematurely died, he was not well and he died, he was in is early thirteen and fans just broke down and there was a massive hysteria, in outside is house and people when just berserk, because huge star die and that, when told to create something called, you know coin age of the term called fandom. So now, fandom is the very common word, very commonly used.

We in Tamil Nadu, we have great act stars, actors, who have these fan clubs. So, we call them fandom refers stars and there images they have based in milk and what not yes there waved in gold in extra. We may even in try to commit to suicide, when a major stars dies that kind of (()). But historically Velentino is one of the most well known in the first documented star to have generated that kind of hysteria. After that, of course, we had major actors stars, Glad cable, James Stewart, Carry grand who had in normal fan following specially among ladies. Even, men wanted to be like Carry grand, Carry grand soon sexuality suspect. He was unknown by sexual. Now, it is all out in the open but he nevertheless married six times and so.

We were talking would you know making of Hollywood star Elizabeth Taylor and also many of these links up and romances and marges would be like studio manufacture devices, just to keep the fans happy. Now, the hero in the fifty, so that those was the forties and the fifties, can you remember any other major stars of the period, fifties ore symbolized majorly by two of our greatest method actors James den as well as Marley Brando both come from New York school, rather than Allay. I will gives briefly another fifties phenomenon, not a star in sense of movie star, but huge huge star in terms of fan following, the beetles as well, where do you have the beetles, close on the heels of we Presley phenomenon. And if you watch a movie called hot days night. Have you, heard of, heard of a there. We will be doing accept from that movie. So, please note of it. Beetles hot days night and help this start in two movies, beautiful movies on and movies, which are still fresh, still very young in approached, so (( )) James dean and Marlin Brando hero in the fifties.

Now, I will give you one minute exercise, to just think over it, who was the major star presiding Brando and Dean. Think about it. Major Hollywood stars presiding (()), but he was not an actor, was say James dean and Marley Brando; great actors phenomenal stars. But who was there before them. Think all your favorite movies, think of the actors staring at, is they are still on heroes and not heroines. Oh god, ham free oh god, good ham free oh god, carry grand, hungry fondant, yes man mantic mantic lift again, New York product, New York acting school product, yes trained by the legendry least stressed work, stella adler, they were the proponents and exponents of method acting in New York. Mantic lift James Dean Brando but mantic lift never generated hysteria Brando and Dean dead, that is the different. So, we agree and free bog ought, carry grand, clock cable, there was a great star during the thirties and the forties, who would invariably star in all this gangster films. You remember his name, he was another major box office drop

James gag nick not James Stewart. James Stewart was a favorite, who hitch cock and also frank capra. But then a hitch cock movie is the hitch cock movie the director before about the title is that kind of star in you so is howard hawks and hitch cocks was two act directors of the classic period, whose name appeared about the title, the name about the title remember, whose auto biography good, frank capra.

So, hero in the fifties, so we will see, how there has been among shift, from the heroes of the thirties forties and the early fifties until Brando and Dean. And what brought about those says, what where those socio cultural changes and the difference acting style and major in and major trends in film making. So, Brando dean and Alwis to when next an change the a way young man could be seen popular culture, so they one not the hypo hypermasculine actor. So, these was the New York trained actors and new new trained in the method acting style and then cinema was dominated by the directors, who are collectively known as the movie berates, hmm movie. Bratess chorsesy, Paul shedder even lucas and spielberg, the movie brats. So, that was the that was those was the seventy of course, spell berg still services but eighty saw again a shift, now look at you watch these method actors in seventies.

Do you watch fight club, is a very different kind of hero or heroism or (( )), you are talking about there we will blood.

It is a sub version of hypo masculinity and Patriarchy. Anything else, Paulthomos and since punch drunk love, magnolia a Tom Cruise magnolia again interrogating the contrast of hypo muscularity, so this is the feature. So, if you think every era define certain kind of movie. The same time also the hypo musculant was like Thomsen (()) hmm but still very confused, not confused about its identity but a man who is not an out an out an anti hero. He is anti hero but still not in the same wean as the burse listen is not taking on the establishment. There are, it is not one man army, against this enemy and for (()) on the armies very, very clear, the enemies very clear right. Very clearly defined assent them, to they also embody the particular, political ideology America.

Now, we do not lot of ambiguity, in all (()) Andersen movies, you have that theme. In all David (()) movies, thus the theme, the recurring theme the enemies lies with the, so James Dean, nineteen year, we are going to analyze phenomenon called James dean and what brought about this phenomenon and then his (()). So, James dean 1931 to 55, some of you have are already familiar with is two great movies rebel with out of the caution east of (()). Those of you want, then please to watch them and third major movie is giant, directed by George Stewens walled with regret, only three movies, three great directors Nicoles Roeg. We already discus the Nicolas grey Roeg, George Stewen and giant and liyacasny east of (()).

So I think, we have try to covered all these three directors. Dean lost his mother at age nine and he was a (()) from his father. So, that was his background, a small town boy and then thought acting would be his profession for life and shifted to New York, got trained

I think and (()) was the first to name him so. And the story goes that, when he was acting with the likes of stars Elizabeth Taylor and rock huts an who had nothing do with method acting was of them, if giant they could never follow what his same they could (()).

They would never and distance Elizabeth Taylor of course, had of some experience, some brush with method acting because she had accreted in place with son with mantic lift. So, she knew what method acting is all about but rock hasten another people in that crew had no idea of what method acting in the all about, they were very uncomfortable with hmm having James dean around. His characters are often in articulate, what do you understand by in articulacy? Not just not being able to express but also extremely confused about, what they want to express. These are theme that runs to the work of the Daniel Lewis also in articles, yes. People you know characters one not able to come to terms with, what do want to say.

Most of his characters, they are an ridden protagonist almost like precast to the great method actors of the seventies. The very popular film and rebel without a cause a takes its cues from the black board jungle.

So in in rebel deans stars and games stack along with nicely wood and (()), who are one another method actors (()) is the boy, who plays, who dies yeah. The kid who dies in the movie and Brando was initially considered for the roll but then he was thought to be old then to play are teenager and if you watch the movie, I just assume some of you have watch the movie and his performance does should (()) influence of Brando. So, rebel without of cause was coin in other term, itself was coin in 1944, before the movie came out. By cytologist, sociologist called Robert lender, who had written written in a book nine in 1946 and a Warner brothers at bought the right to the book and I am coating something from the novel from the book, sorry the (()) is a rebel a religious disobeyer of prevailing coats and standard coated rebel without cause, educated without a Slovene, revolutionary without a program.

So, that is what define a rebel, according to Robert Glider. So, who is a rebel, rebel is the milestone in the creating of new ideas about young people. The novel as well, the book

as well the movie, basically deals with the concept of un focuses rage, these young people full of rage, but they do not know rage is against, whether is that teachers are the authority figures, you know the law maker etcetera at all the period. Presidents in cinematic histories from marlin Brando's role as a motor cycle gang leaders, you know it was one of those, today we call them bike flicks, right. From the biker flicks by one of this marlin Brando played the role, in the wild one in the 1953.

You know influence of Marlon Brando, they are like for reaching you watch a movie like Gulam, Amirkhan's gulam, which movie is it based on? He is, he is boxer, he is ask to throw again, by his brother, and the brother is in league with the, the so called you know, small time goons and (()). So which movie is it based on? And then the brother is killed, he is the peace maker between various people, he is also lawyer in the movie by right, and there is another activist to gets killed and then are the hero, he turns the in rebel, so for he is a drifter, but then when he watch his brother die, and when he watch is this active is, when he turns into revolutionary of sorts.

The one man army against this army of goons; which movie is it based on? On the Waterfront. So, but if you how many of you have watched Gulam, Amirkhan's gulam? No, do watch it and watch it back to back with on the waterfront, also rebel without cause. Now, why are we talking about gulam at this point, because on the waterfront, there is no by biker at gang, but in gulam there is one. Do you remember, there is a group of biker who always arrives on the scene whenever, there is some problem and there always on bikes, so biker gang and they help the hero out in one of its major moments of crises.

So, that seen total from the while now and also we had phenomenon called (()) in 1950s and along with Brando and (()) created kind of role model that alter the way, young man pursuit for the so called enemies. So they one to rebel against the concept of (()), because we have been like the striped of former masculinity by (()) so (()) hand begged father bossy mother, and that something that you find and rebel without cause as what can you do? When you have to be a man James asked is the father at one point at the movie, their, because why are you so dominated by my mother. So, the cause nothing really he does not have any cause, it is a story which takes place within 24 hours, yeah very tightly in plan it well tightly plot a structure and

He is not the hypo hypermasculinies identifying a certain problem. That was identified by many people before him that we men are slowly a masculating men in American society. Ann being a man that what his says about is father, if we had guts to knock mom cold ones, then maybe she would be happy and she would starts picking on him. The other issues were like jivani delinquency, and also the conclusion is that grown up also do not have solution to teenagers problems. James dean phenomenon, we were talking about making of James dean phenomenon. So, just three movies and today is marital while, one was the style; the way he was the style in the movie, he is not basically remembered for giant, in giant ages forty years but the end of the movie.

You see him like the fifty year old or late fifty something like that. East of east indies yes, very respectable movie by the great a aliya hazan; hazan got the major junk of credit and also based on classic American novel but rebel made James dean what he was. And his iconic red jacket, the hair style we are talking about start here. And fast car, fast bikes all these since you do not scene giant. So, who are fans? That is my question to you, are you a fan of any actor? Yes something (Audio not clear) is major actor he may not be a star, he may not be huge (()), because see he never cultivated himself that way he did not play the star game. Thus also one thing he could have done, that one thing there are some people to play that image of heroism. Daniel Delewis never repeated himself and never (()) image for himself. Same can be said about (()) he never played those games but there are certain people, who do these things. James dean, perhaps we concert that he played it but by default perhaps it of is very premature death. He has come to be come to become, you know all time role model star, so fans who are fans, now we see a picture and actor in change where.

They want to (()) you this is fan, this is becoming part of fandom, this is what the fandom thus to you (()) you, how do you institutionalized? We say right he is not an actor institution him, how do you get institutionalized? I am sure all of you know, what are the practice, what do people what do fans do, we have star great actor star Sharuk khan and we see him always surround it by fans fans and also who plays (()) the media fan scene, fancy popular magazine, media. Nowadays, you also have social network sites. These are the twitter, face book and all though sent of things. So, what do they do they institutionalized songs stalls (()) followers, yes. Can you give me some examples? Yes, (()) very built it good. I am sure there are certain stars; there are North Country, who are institutionalized by religious strokes.

Now, what does meant to have to been have to your own fandom, what is fandom? Fandom until the meaning of being of fan people coming together and institutionalizing someone; fandom is studies investigated how fans express their likes and dislikes and nowadays, you have all kinds of things, all kinds of medium to for fans, all kinds of

platform to fans express the likes and dislikes. So, the moment, the movie released, next day would be millions of posts about that actor, about that movie, because you have fan following, fans are following you literally, nowadays on social media. Fans discuss comment and write on films perhaps, they are not qualified to do that but they do that because they fans they have every (()) do so.

Fans, of course, they can be manipulative and they can be manipulated as well by marketing forces. Can you give me some instance, how fans can be manipulated? Well every time, there is a new movie coming coming up you just have to generate certain kind of is story about star, then you look at the hysteria that follows among the fans. Net leeds to I am I am there are numerous example, and if you watch it very carefully, you we find in anywhere in one and specially north countries whenever, there is the major movie upon release, there is always some kind of controversy.

Because that generates interest, thus the way media stars manipulate fans fans will be there but then is another thing is, another art to manipulate the emotion, that will of course, result in more would false. Sometimes, fans influence also control the product. Can you give me some example (()) movie, which in Kerala bought ten years back. Just staring both Mohanlal and (()). So, thing is, she has to choose between either are them we actually came out two endings of movie one is choose an Mohan lal and the other one chose is (()). You cannot (()) of fans. So, yeah these (()) different the so depending on whoever had more fan. Manirathnam Selpathy is based on which a pic? Mahabharatham and which role is Rajinikhanth, superstar right Rajinikhanth is sing karna is right. What happensto Karna in Mahabharatham? Does in dying thalapathi?

We were just talking about kolev; kolev original screenplay had Bachchan dying at the end but because he had just come out near death experience, how many of you are not familiar with koli accident. Mr. Bachchan almost died during the fight scene, during fight scene during a action scene, during the shooting of the movie and he was hospitalized many months, following that accident and it first sometimes rumors would having the that is already dead and those we are talking about 1982 when we did not have all these media channel and extra television channels and so many newspapers and magazines. But fans would strong the hospital throw out and some some occasionally to the rumor would be floating in the air, that Mr. Bachchan is no longer alike whatever. But the movie came out it and the movie was eventually completed, and was released in 1983, the original screenplay dying at the end, because he has come out of this, yeah near death experience, the director had to the change of movie. Now, you can show, bachchan dying on screen.

And interestingly, after (( )), he is the he is carrier start going down because see, you have been the fight that extent. After the anything, anything whatever you do, cannot measure up to that level and the other movie followed by the just not there, am in there just in the capture the phenomenon. The only movie as far as I can remember, which had bachchan dying, after the coolly incident was (()) path on it was miserable flop, it was flop for variety of resents. But one of the reason was flopping was, it people were not thus not interest in see him as hero one yeah and also the fact that he dies on screen. Because people where no long interest in watching him. They was another lesser known movie called me mayan hazzard based on frank capras meet john dow, which again had dying on screen and the movie was even release properly, bachchan movie not finding a release.

So, the legend continues, we have a numerous James dean appreciation society. Wanna brother even, made a movie a short documentary called the James dean story in 1957. There are several biography and he is also gay icon, his bio graphics the mutant king and James dean bole award broken dreams, there another biography called, that is called James dean and then silver screen (( )) and the cover, you can see James dean, marlin Brando, (( )). He also represented cult of youth, it earner young, it learnedly alight and the only two deaths, that can match up to his legendry and death that phenomenon, that
