



Note: Ngspice will automatically be installed if you have already installed Oscad. So, one can directly start practising ngspice tutorials.

1 The procedure to install ngspice in Linux OS

To follow the installation procedure, you are required to be connected to the Internet. You can install ngspice in two ways:

1. Through Synaptic Package Manager. For this you must have Synaptic Package Manager installed on your machine.
2. Through the Terminal.

1.1 The procedure to install ngspice using Synaptic Package Manager

1. On Ubuntu 10.04 - Click on `System >> Administration >> Synaptic Package Manager`.
2. On Ubuntu 11.04 and higher,
 - (a) Press the Window key on your keyboard to open DashHome.
 - (b) Type `Synaptic Package Manager`.
 - (c) Click on the `Synaptic Package Manager` option.
3. Enter your admin password.
4. Click on `OK`.
5. In the search box, type `ngspice`.
6. Click on the `ngspice` check box >> click on `Mark for Installation`.
7. Click on `Apply`.
8. The installation will take a few minutes to complete, depending on your Internet speed.
9. After the installation completes, open the terminal and type `ngspice -v`.
10. This will display ngspice version number.
11. This message shows that the installation is successfully done.

1.2 The procedure to install ngspice through Terminal

1. To install ngspice, open the terminal.
2. To do so, press `Alt + CTRL + T` keys together.
3. Type `sudo apt-get install ngspice`
4. It will prompt for the admin password.
5. Type your password.
6. The installation will take a few minutes to complete.
7. Ngspice will be installed.
8. To check the installation, type `ngspice -v`. This will display ngspice version number.
9. This shows that the installation is successfully done.

2 The procedure to install ngspice in Windows OS

1. To follow the installation procedure, you should be required to be connected to the Internet.
2. Go to <https://sourceforge.net/projects/ngspice/files/ng-spice-rework/26/>
3. From the list, download `ngspice-26-140112.zip` .
4. Unzip the zip folder to your desired directory. This zip file contains MS Windows executable files for `ngspice`.
5. To launch `ngspice`, locate `spice/bin` in this directory.
6. Double click on `ngspice.exe` file.
7. The successful installation will open the ngspice terminal window.
